



Learning and Fun Rolled into One





हाल ही में देश ने चंद्रयान-3 को तैयार किया और चाँद के उस छोर में भेजा जहाँ अमेरिका और रूस जैसे देशों ने भी भेजने की कोशिश की और विफल हुए। इसका निरीक्षण श्री एस. सोमनाथ और हमारे देश के विश्व प्रसिद्ध प्रधानमंत्री श्री नरेंद्र मोदी के सान्निध्य में हुआ है।

इसका लॉन्च समय 14 जुलाई 2023, दोपहर 2:35 पर हुआ और इसने सभी के दिलों में एक जिज्ञासा उत्पन्न कर दी, चंद्रयान ने लगभग 3.84 लाख किलोमीटर की यात्रा तय की और यह वजन मे लगभग 3900 किलो था, इसको अपने निर्धारित स्थल पर पहुँचने में 1 महीना 10 दिन का समय लगा और उसने अपने कदम 23 अगस्त सांय 6:04 पर रखे।

वह पल सम्पूर्ण देशवासियों के लिए गर्व का पल था और सभी का सीना गर्व से चौड़ा हो गया। सभी वैज्ञानिक जो इस मिशन से जुड़े थे उन सभी को देशवासियों ने बहुत-बहुत शुभकामनाएँ दी।अत: एक बार फिर से भारत के वैज्ञानिकों ने विज्ञान के बल पर अपनी धाक जमाई और भारत को सुजलाम् सुफलाम् का मार्ग दिखाते हुए भारत को सोने की चिड़िया बनाने के मार्ग पर आगे बढ़ाया।

ऐसे वैज्ञानिकों को हमारे देश का प्रत्येक नागरिक दिल से सम्मान करते हुए धन्यवाद देता है।


