- Online registration is compulsory for admission in class-1. Without online registration, no admission will be entitled.
- Parents must fill out the online Registration Form carefully as per the details given in the Birth Certificate issued by the Competent Authority.
- After the successful payment of the registration fee ₹ 500/- online, you may take the printout of the Confirmation Page and the fee receipt.
- The print out of the confirmation page & fee receipt must be submitted in the school office along with the applicable supporting documents mentioned in the checklist on 19th December 2025.
- An affidavit also be submitted on ₹ 50/- non-judicial stamp paper sworn before a notary, 1st Class Magistrate or Executive Magistrate stating that the Candidate's Name, Date of Birth, Father's Name & Mother's Name mentioned in the certificates like, Birth Certificate, Aadhaar, etc. are the exact and correct one and no request for changes/correction will be made by the student/parents in the future. - No Registration Form will be accepted without the required self-attested documents. No form will be accepted after the given schedule whatsoever.
- The entrance test will be conducted on 31st January 2026 and the submitted documents will be verified before the test. Incomplete or incorrect Registration Forms will automatically be disqualified & rejected from the admission process.
