Students can select only one of the given categories under each section.



Rules for solo dance

- Willing Students can submit their names and pen drive (with name) by 16.04.26.
- Class teachers will conduct a semi-final round in the class room and will select 2 students from each section by 18.04.2026.
- The students will bring their songs in a pen drive for screening. Class teachers will assemble all the songs in a single Pen Drive and submit it to Nitin Sir for semi-final round by 17.04.26.
- Class teachers will give final two dance tracks in a single pen drive to Ma'am Itisha for final round.
- Maximum time allotted for the dance is 2 mins.
- Students are allowed to use props.
- Use of colour, party popper, sprays, confetti etc. are strictly prohibited.
- Students will come to school in their costume and make up.
- Stage Practice will be given to the students on 23.04.26 by stage duty teacher
- Class teachers will make sure that song should not contain any inappropriate words.
- The decision of the judges will be final.

Criteria for Judgment:

Costume, Song selection, Choreography, Stage Presence & Overall presentation

Rules for Solo Singing

- Willing Students can submit their names by 16.04.26.
- Class teachers will conduct a semi-final round in the class room and will select 2 students from each section by 18.04.2026.
- Students who wish to use a karaoke track of their song (MP3 format) must submit it to the class teachers in a pen drive (in the folder with their name) by 16.04.26.
- The maximum time allotted for the competition is two minutes.
- Class teachers will assemble all the karaoke tracks in a single Pen Drive and submit it to Nitin Sir for semi-final round by 17.04.26.
- Class teachers will give all karaoke tracks from their class on a single USB drive to Ma'am Itisha for final round.
- Students will come in grey uniform for solo singing.
- Stage practice will be given to the students on April 23, 2025, by the stage duty teachers
- Class teachers will make sure that song should not contain any inappropriate words.
- The decision of the judges will be final.

Criteria for Judgement

Song Selection, Voice Quality, Intonation (Pitch Accuracy) & Stage Presence and Presentation

Rules for Poster making

- The poster must be made on the given theme.
- Students should bring their own materials (A3 size drawing sheet, colours, pencils, etc.).
- Use of inappropriate language or images is strictly not allowed.
- Posters must be neat, creative, and colourful.
- Students must complete their posters within the given time limit (1 hour).
- Name, class, roll no and section should be written clearly on the top right corner of the poster.
- The decision of the judges will be final.
- Class teacher will select best articles (max. 5 in each category) and will prepare a list category wise after the children leave and arrange them in ascending order of their roll no. with the following details. Roll No, Class, Section, Name and gender.

Criteria for Judgement

Creativity, neatness, message clarity and overall presentation

Rules for Clay Modelling

- The clay model must be made on the given theme.
- Students should bring their own materials (Air dry clay, pot and basic tools.).
- No readymade or prepared items are allowed.
- Clay model must be neat, creative, and colourful.
- Students must complete their art within the given time limit (1 hour).
- Students will put a separate tag which will include Name, class, Roll no. and section
- The decision of the judges will be final.
- Class teacher will select best articles (max. 5 in each category) and will prepare a list category wise after the children leave and arrange them in ascending order of their roll no. with the following details. Roll No, Class, Section, Name and gender.
